Policy workshops

- Targeted at EU and national level policy makers
- First is to be held on November 28th in Brussels
- Aims to inform policy makers of project aims and activities, interesting approaches identified to date
- Identify the needs of policy makers

ProMenPol Conferences

- Phase 2 conference aims
 - to gain feedback on each of the toolkits
 - to launch the concept of the pilot projects, generate pilot project design guidelines and to canvass for participating sites
 - April-June 2008
- Phase 3 conference aims
 - Review reports on pilot implementations in each of the three settings
 - Obtain feedback on these reports
 - July-September 2009

Establishing the field trials

- Identifying support needs of pilot sites
- Circulating drafts of support proposals to pilot sites
- Initiating the pilots
- November 2007-Spring 2008 and beyond
