Health inequalities

- Inequalities in access to healthcare produce inequities in health outcomes
- But, increased spending on healthcare services has had marginal impact on overall “health”
- Health inequalities derive from social, financial, public health and educational causes
- The financial crisis will widen inequalities unless vulnerable groups are specifically targeted
